THE DISASTER AT Ai (Josh 7:1-5)

THE DESPAIR FROM Ai (Josh 7:6-9)

THE PLACE (6b) before the ark of the Lord until the eventide,

THE PEOPLE (6c) he and the elders of Israel, and put dust upon their heads.

THE CRITICISM OF GOD (7abc) And Joshua said, Alas, O Lord God, wherefore hast thou at all brought this people over Jordan, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us?

THE CRY OF REGRETS (7d) would to God we had been content, and dwelt on the other side Jordan!

THE CONFUSION OVER THE DEFEAT (8a) O Lord, what shall I say, when Israel turneth their backs before their enemies!

THE CONCLUSION ABOUT THE ENEMY (9a) For the Canaanites and all the inhabitants of the land shall hear of it, and shall environ us round, and cut off our name from the earth:

THE ORDER TO JOSHUA (10) And the Lord said unto Joshua, Get thee up; wherefore liest thou thus upon thy face?

THE SIN IS DESCRIBED (11)

TRANSGRESSION (11ab) Israel

hath sinned, and they have also transgressed my covenant which I commanded them:

TRESPASS (11c,) for they have even

taken of the accursed thing

THE STEALING (11d,f) and have also stolen.... and they have put it even among their own stuff. **THE SACRILEGE** (11 e) and dissembled (illustration **Mal 3:8-11**) (application **Acts 5:1-11**)

THE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SIN (20) And Achan answered Joshua, and said, Indeed I have sinned against the Lord God of Israel,

THE ANTAGONIST OF SIN (20) Indeed I have sinned against the Lord God of Israel, and thus have I done

THE ATTRACTIVENESS OF SIN (21)

HE SAW THE OBJECTS when I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight,

HE SINNED FOR THE OBJECTS then I coveted them **(Exo 20:17)**

HE STOLE THE OBJECTS took them

(Josh 6:19, 24.) Exo 20:15

THE ANONYMITY OF SIN (21) behold, they are hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.

THE EVIDENCE (22-23)

THE EXPEDIENCE (22) So Joshua sent messengers, and they ran unto the tent; and, behold, it was hid in his tent, and the silver under it.

THE EXAMINATION (23) And they took them out of the midst of the tent, and brought them unto Joshua, and unto all the children of Israel, and laid them out before the Lord.
