OUR RETIRED MISSIONARIES TO THE PHILIPPINES



Dear Pastor and Church:

Since our last letter, Sue fell and broke her leg. She is now out of the hospital and rehab. Although she can only walk a few halting steps, she is getting stronger. We have health workers here almost every day, and our family helps the rest of the time. Life throws us some curve balls, but your support and prayers are one constant blessing.

The members of the church in the Philippines are able to gather again in their buildings, but they are limited to the ages between teenagers and fifties. The church is still in need of a pastor. It seems there is confusion as to who the members of the committee charged with the task of searching for a new pastor are.

It has been my experience that even members of a church often have a difficult time learning to tithe or support missions. While in Manila, we had a man and his family visit us for the first time on the closing day of our mission conference. During our faith promise time, he promised a good amount for missions. The trustees asked me about including that goodly amount to our annual missions' budget. As a "WISE AND PRUDENT" leader, I knew if we did and those funds didn't come in, our members might be discouraged at the end of the year so we didn't include it. The next couple of weeks he did not attend, so I felt that I had made the right decision. However, the third week he came to church and gave for three weeks. I learned that he was a government district engineer and traveled for 2 weeks each month. He and his family joined the church and were great members. I realized that Jesus was saying to me, "O thou of little faith!" I am so grateful that First Baptist Church of Ruskin is faithful!
