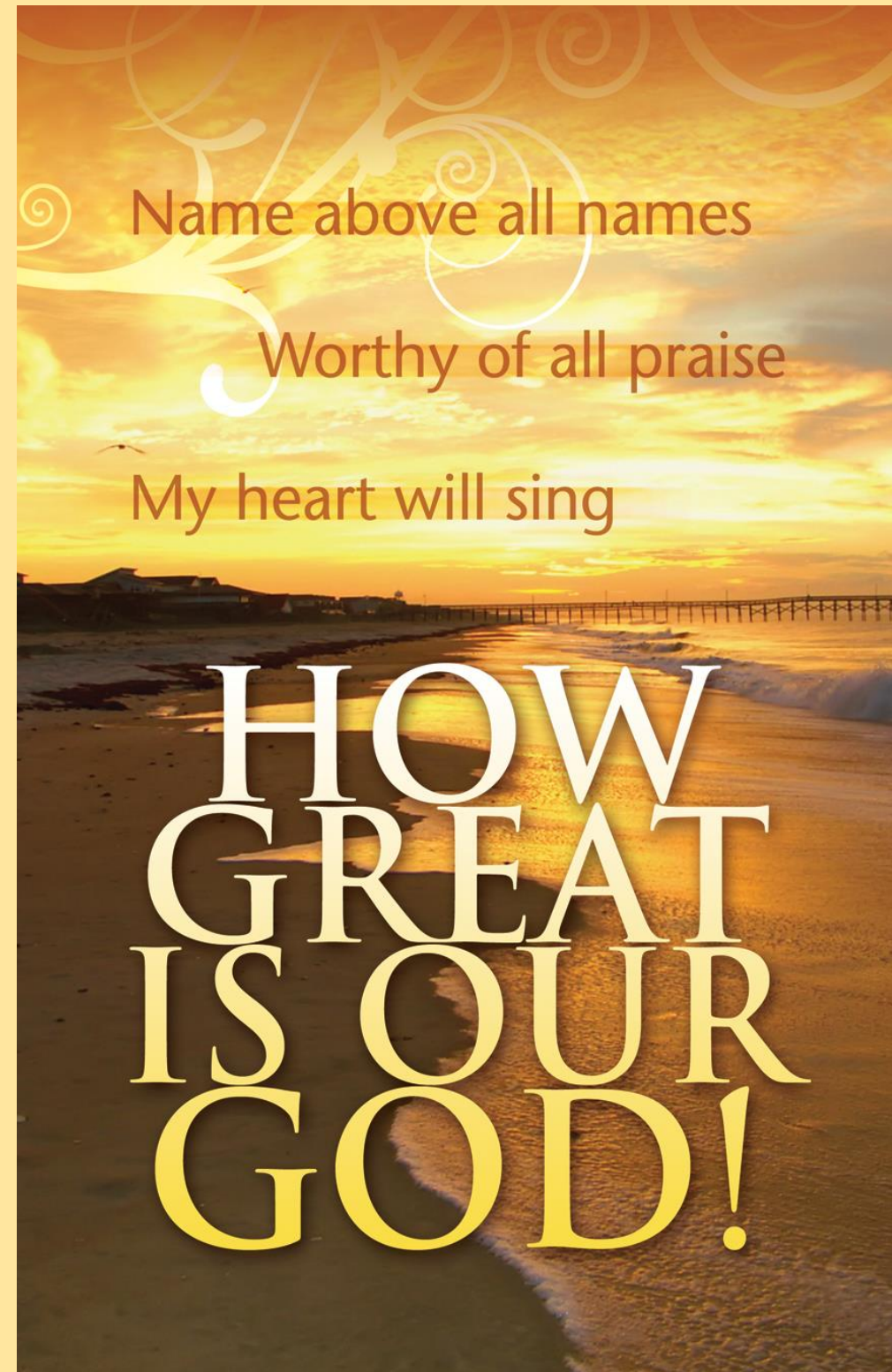

## TERRY & MYRA UNRUH OUR MISSIONARIES TO SRI LANKA

Life after curfew began May 18th, but places of worship were not allowed to gather until June 14th and then only 50 congregants, all wearing masks. Each one had to have his temperature checked before entering, and police were posted at every church to see that these rules were enforced. By June 21st, they allowed 100 people under the same rules, but that did not deter most of our members, and we even had visitors!

Thank the Lord that we were able to livestream our services from the very first Sunday under curfew. No one was saved that we know of through the online services, but we do know many who had never attended services watched the online ones.

However, Subbiah, a Hindu man who had started visiting the church before Covid, continued watching online. As soon as the church was open, he came and accepted Christ five days later and was baptized along with his wife, Ranjani, a Buddhist. On June 28th, they were baptized along with 3 others.

On Wednesday evening, July 1st, we received a text message asking if we could meet someone BEFORE the service who wanted to be saved! What a joy it was to lead Srivantha, a Buddhist, to the Lord. After five years of praying for him, he had starting coming to church with his wife. Now their whole family is united in Christ with their two children who were saved first! Pray that they would follow the Lord in baptism soon and continue to grow spiritually and bring others to Christ.

Myra and I arrived in the U.S. on July 2nd to celebrate our 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary and the birth of our grandson, William Remington Unruh born on July 1st. Our “little jewel” came into this world at 7.7 lbs. & 21 inches with a set of lungs for the making of a PREACHER!
