JUDGMENT BY THE HYPOCRITE (2:1-6)

WHAT HE FEELS (2:1-2) *Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things. ² But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things.*

(Matt 5:27-28) (Mark 7:21-22) (1 John 3:15)

(2 Cor 10:12) (Rom 2:1)

(Matt 7:1-2) (Rom 2:2)

WHAT HE FINDS (2:3) *And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?*

WHAT HE FORGETS (2:4) *Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?*

(Luke 7:41-43) (Rom 6:23a)

WHAT HE FACES (2:5-6) *but after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God; ⁶ who will render to every man according to his deeds*

JUDGMENT BY THE HYPOCRITE (2:1-6)

JUDGMENT ON THE HYPOCRITE (2:7-16)

THE HYPOCRITE IS JUDGED ACCORDING TO HIS WORKS (2:7-10)

2 Cor 5:10, 1 Cor 3:11-15, Rev 20:11-15

(Rom 2:6) *God will render to every man according to his deeds.*

GOD WEIGHS THE REASONS FOR A PERSON'S BEHAVIOR (2:7-8)

THE MORALIST - THOSE WHO SOUGHT SALVATION BY WORKS – (1:7) *to them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life:*

(Acts 4:2) (John 14:6)

THE IMMORAL - THOSE WHO DID NOT SEEK SALVATION - (1:8) *but unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,*

GOD WEIGHS THE RESULTS OF A PERSON'S BEHAVIOR – (2:9-10) *tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile; ¹⁰ but glory, honor, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile:*

THE HYPOCRITE IS JUDGED ACCORDING TO HIS WORTH (2:11-16)

GOD'S JUDGMENT IS DISCRIMINATING (11-15)

GOD WEIGHS A PERSON'S ADVANTAGES

(2:11-12) *for there is no respect of persons with God. ¹² For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law;*

GOD WEIGHS A PERSON'S ATTITUDES (13-15)

ATTITUDE OF THE JEWS (13) *(for not*

the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.

ACTIONS OF THE GENTILES (14-15)

WHAT THE GENTILES DO NOT HAVE

(14) *For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves:*

WHAT THE GENTILES DO HAVE (15)

A WRITTEN LAW - (15a) *which shew the work of the law written in their hearts*

A WORKING CONSCIENCE - (15b) *their conscience also bearing witness*

A WEAK EXCUSE - (15b)

and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)

GOD'S JUDGMENT IS DEVASTATING (2:16) *in the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.*
