OUR MISSIONARY TO THE DEAF PAUL MOSLEY



Dear Pastor and praying friends,

I trust the Lord has been working in your life and using you to lead more people to our Savior. He surely has been doing the same in my life. Over the past year, the Lord has shown me how He can use me as **His witness** to the Deaf, as **His servant** to help others, and as **His messenger** to share the need for someone to bring the Gospel to the Deaf. He continues to teach me how I can grow in my relationship with Him. I am thankful for what the Lord has done in and through me.

As 2021 unfolded, the Lord led me to a small country church in Scottsboro, Alabama one Sunday evening. I originally planned to visit a church in Huntsville but soon discovered their evening services were temporarily postponed. As I made my way back to Ringgold, Georgia, I noticed the bright shining lights emanating from a small country church. I pulled into the parking lot and hesitated to enter the church because it appeared the service was already over. As I contemplated what I should do, all the men in the church exited the building and came in my direction. I immediately introduced myself as a missionary to the Deaf looking for a church to visit. The pastor invited me inside and asked me to share my burden for the Deaf with his congregation. The church was moved by my testimony and my burden for the Deaf, and they took up a love offering. I don't know how the Lord does it, but He surely knows how to lead His servants to a **specific place** at a **specific time** and use them in a **special way**.

Pray the Lord will provide more opportunities for me to complete my deputation in 2021. **Pray** for traveling mercies as I present my ministry in churches. **Pray** the Lord will guide churches and pastor to support my ministry. **Pray** for the Go Deaf Missions team and our upcoming trip to Peru in May.
