Rom 1:16 – “For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth;”

The offer of salvation for sin is universal.

THE EXPERIENCE OF JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH
OUR THEOLOGICAL STANDING (1-2)

Therefore being justified by faith,

JUSTIFICATION BRINGS PEACE WITH GOD (5:1) we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

JUSTIFICATION PROVIDES ACCESS TO GOD (5:2) by whom also we have access by faith into this grace

JUSTIFICATION GIVES ACCEPTANCE BEFORE GOD (5:2) wherein we stand.

Justification by faith changes the life of the one justified for it offers a relationship with God.

OUR PRACTICAL STATION – ON EARTH
(5:3-5) *And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; ⁴ and patience, experience; and experience, hope ⁵ and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.*

JUSTIFICATION DOES NOT MEAN EXEMPTION FROM TROUBLE (5:3) *but we glory in tribulations also:*

Rom 4:20-21 “he staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; ²¹ and being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.”

Isa 53:3 - Our Savior ... “...a man of sorrow and acquainted with grief... he was despised...”

Rom 8:16-18 “The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: ¹⁷ and if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.¹⁸ For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.”

We have Security in Christ

Why should we glory in tribulations?
We are a Witness for Christ

JUSTIFICATION ALLOWS FOR ENDURANCE of EXPERIENCES (5:3b-4a) *knowing that tribulation worketh patience; ⁴ and patience, experience;*

TRIBULATION WORKS PATIENCE

James 1:2-3 *My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; ³ knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.*

PATIENCE (WORKS) EXPERIENCE

JUSTIFICATION PROVIDES ENCOURAGEMENT & HOPE (5:4b-5) *and experience, hope ⁵ and hope maketh not ashamed;*

EXPERIENCE (WORKS) HOPE
HOPE MAKETH NOT ASHAMED

Mal 3:9-11

John 16:33 *In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.*

1 Thes 3:4 *For verily, when we were with you, we told you before that we should suffer tribulation;*

2 Cor 1:4 *Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; ⁴ who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.*

Rom 12:12 *we are to be rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation;*
