

AMBER YINGLING GIVING HOPE TO THE HOPELESS IN THE PHILIPPINES

The Lord continues to bless and provide for me as I continue to choose to be obedient to His leading. I was blessed to have my dad, John Yingling, here with me for 19 days last month. I had not physically seen or hugged my dad for almost 2 years. The first embrace was extremely special, and though the last one was bittersweet, we both cried tears of joy as we focused on the greatness of God.

One thing the Lord showed me through my dad's preaching was how important my calling is. At times, I have asked, "Why the Philippines, Lord, when they have the Gospel already and are mostly receptive to hearing it?" I have often struggled why not some other unreached nation or people group. As my dad was preaching a message on mission and the unreached people groups around the world, I heard God's still small voice whisper to me, "Amber, the orphaned, the abused, and the abandoned children here are your unreached people group." Some are called to an unreached nation while some are called to an unreached person like a child who feels forgotten and alone. The Philippines has over two million orphans.

In my last prayer letter, I asked you to pray for my housing in Pampanga where I want to finish my first missionary term at an orphanage to get hands-on training. I was seeking a fully furnished two-bedroom house or apartment in a safe environment. I asked a fellow BIO missionary who lives in the area to help me inquire. After one week she told me she found one. The owner is a Christian who works overseas. When he heard I was a missionary, he offered it to me for half the going rate which was even under my budgeted amount!

Thank you for your prayers and praise the Lord for His answers to those prayers!
