

JOEL DESIR, OUR MISSIONARY TO HAITI

Dear Church members and family,

Greeting in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. I want to say thank you to those who pray for me and the Haitian community.

Haiti is facing such a difficult situation right now. The gangsters control about 70% of the country. They are kidnapping, stealing, and killing. Because of this situation, I am hindered from starting the fourth church I was planning this year. All those things do not move me to quit and change a mission field. It encourages me to preach the Gospel more. Please pray for my country. Almost every day I cry and pray for dying souls in Haiti.

During the last two months, we had over 100 people receive Christ as their Personal Savior, and 20 of them followed in baptism. In December, we had our "God Save Haiti Conference" that lasted four days. For three of those days, we had 360 in attendance, and our Anniversary Sunday we had 425. Each day we saw people saved and baptized.

On December 4th, we held an inaugural service in the newly built auditorium in Sodo. One hundred people attended. The church is doing well.

Please pray for the church in Lascahobas. We need \$10,000 to finish protecting the land with cement blocks and a big gate.

One of the salvation stories I would like to share with you is about a young man named Rouso. I asked Rouso to give his salvation testimony one evening, and he said he was saved because his former pastor had tapped his head a few times with the Bible and then baptized him. I told him baptism does not save. I told him he would go to Hell because he had never accepted Christ as his Personal Savior. Later he told me he didn't want to go to Hell and asked for help. I had the privilege of leading him to Christ and after he accepted Christ as his Savior, then he was baptized. Praise the Lord! Please pray for him.
