IT WAS USUAL (3) Shechem's "soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob." 2 Sam 13:15, Gen 34:19

<u>IT WAS GENEROUS</u> (10) "And ye shall dwell with us: and the land shall be before you; dwell and trade ye therein and get you possessions therein.

<u>IT WAS NOT APOLOGETIC</u> (11-12) "And Shechem said unto her father and unto her brethren, let me find grace in your eyes, and what ye shall say unto me I will give. ¹²Ask me never so much dowry and gift, and I will give according as ye shall say unto me: but give me the damsel to wife."

THE CONDONERS (25) All the males of the city.
