<u>A DISAPPOINTMENT</u> - Reuben (Gen 35: 21-22) And Israel journeyed, and spread his tent beyond the tower of Edar. <sup>22</sup> And it came to pass, when Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine: and Israel heard it.

(Gen 35:27-29) And Jacob came unto Isaac his father unto Mamre, unto the city of Arbah, which is Hebron, where Abraham and Isaac sojourned. <sup>28</sup> And the days of Isaac were an hundred and fourscore years. <sup>29</sup> And Isaac gave up the ghost, and died, and was gathered unto his people, being old and full of days: and his sons Esau and Jacob buried him.

THE EVENTS OF ISAAC'S LIFE (35:28)
Gen 25:26, 37:2, 41:46, 45:6, 47:9 & 47:28

When Esau and Jacob were born - Isaac was 60
When Jacob left for Haran - Isaac was 137, Jacob 77
When Joseph was born - Isaac was 151, Jacob 91
When Joseph was sold into slavery — (he was 17)
Isaac was 168, Jacob 108

<u>THE ACT Of DEATH</u> (35:29) And Isaac gave up the ghost, and died, (ghost = spirit)

# Medical description of death

- (1) <u>irreversible cessation of circulatory and respiratory</u> <u>functions</u> (no heartbeat or breathing) or
- (2) <u>irreversible cessation of all functions of the entire</u> brain (no brain activity)

# **Biblical description of death**

Spirit (Gen 35:29) when the spirit leaves the body
Soul (Gen 2:7) (Rev 6:9, 20:4) 2 Cor 5:8,10 to be
absent from the body, ... to be present with the Lord."
1 Pet 1:9 "the end of your faith, even the salvation of
your souls." 1 Pet 3:20 "the Bishop of our souls"
1 Pet 4:19 suffer according to the will of God commit
their souls to the Lord in well doing." (Heb 3:18)
