THE RESURRECTION (3/31/24 AM) **1 Corinthians 15:1-7, 12-22**

Ezekiel 8:16-18

#1 - Jesus rose from the dead before dawn (Matt 28:1-2) In the end of the sabbath (7th day), as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre. ² And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it.

#2 – Jesus' body laid in the tomb for 3 days and 3 nights. Matt 12:40 "For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the whale's belly so shall the son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth."

#3 - <u>Jesus was buried at dusk</u> (Mark 15:42-47, Matt 27:57-60)

(1 Cor 15:3-4) "Moreover brethren, I declare unto the gospel...3For I delivered unto you all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins, according to the Scriptures. 4and that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the Scriptures."

(Mark 15:42, Matt 27:62) "the day of Preparation" —

The day before the Passover

John 12:1-19 (7) "Then Jesus six days before the Passover came to Bethany

John 12:12 On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, ¹³ took branches of palm trees

THE PREDICTIONS OF JESUS

Matt 17:9 - Mount of Transfiguration,

Matt 20:17-19 "And Jesus ... and said unto them, ¹⁸Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn him to death, ¹⁹And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify him: and the third day he shall rise again.

Matt 26:31-32 ³²But after I am risen again, I will go before you into Galilee."

THE PLAN OF THE PRIESTS AND PHARISEES

Matt 27:62-65 Now the next day, that followed the day of the preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees came together unto Pilate, ⁶³ saying, ..., while he was yet alive, After three days I will rise again. ⁶⁴ Command therefore that the sepulchre be made sure until the third day, ⁶⁵ Pilate said unto them, Ye have a watch: go your way, make it as sure as ye can.

THE PREACHING OF PETER

Acts 2:21 - It shall come to pass that whosover calleth upon the name of the Lord, Shall be saved.)

Acts 2:23-24 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: ²⁴Whom God hath raised up."

Acts 3:13-15 15 killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses."

Acts 4:8-12 ¹⁰Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, ¹²Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."

1 Cor 15:1-22 Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; ⁴And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures: ⁵And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve: ⁶After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep. ⁷After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles. ⁸And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

²⁰But <u>now is Christ risen from the dead,</u> and become the firstfruits of them that slept. ²¹For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. ²²For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive."
