



AMBER YINGLING OUR MISSIONARY IN THE PHILIPPINE ISLANDS

Dear Church family,

As is stated in my last letter, I AM GETTING MARRIED!!! In January I was able to take a month-long trip to Negros. While there I got to know my fiancé Jonell's extended family and members of his church. The Lord allowed me to serve along side Jonell during several events. At the youth camp, I had the opportunity to be one of the lecturers. Jonell served as the keynote speaker and camp director. We even got a chance to look at some possible locations for an orphanage. Pray God will continue to direct our paths for this future ministry.

I will be saying goodbye at the end of this month to the Philippine Baptist Orphanage where I have been serving, and I will be moving to the island of Negros. I will be driving 4 hours to the first port, riding a cargo ship for 18 hours, driving 2 more hours to the next port, taking another cargo ship for 3 hours, and then driving the last 2 hours to the city where I will be living. This is the most cost-effective way as it will cost about \$500 in all. Pray for safety for this move.

In Negros, the Lord has provided a small house in Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental. This is the city where we will be married. After Jonell and I are married, we plan to continue living there until after our furlough trip to the US. Our home is a cute little two-bedroom house where everything is furnished except the appliances.
